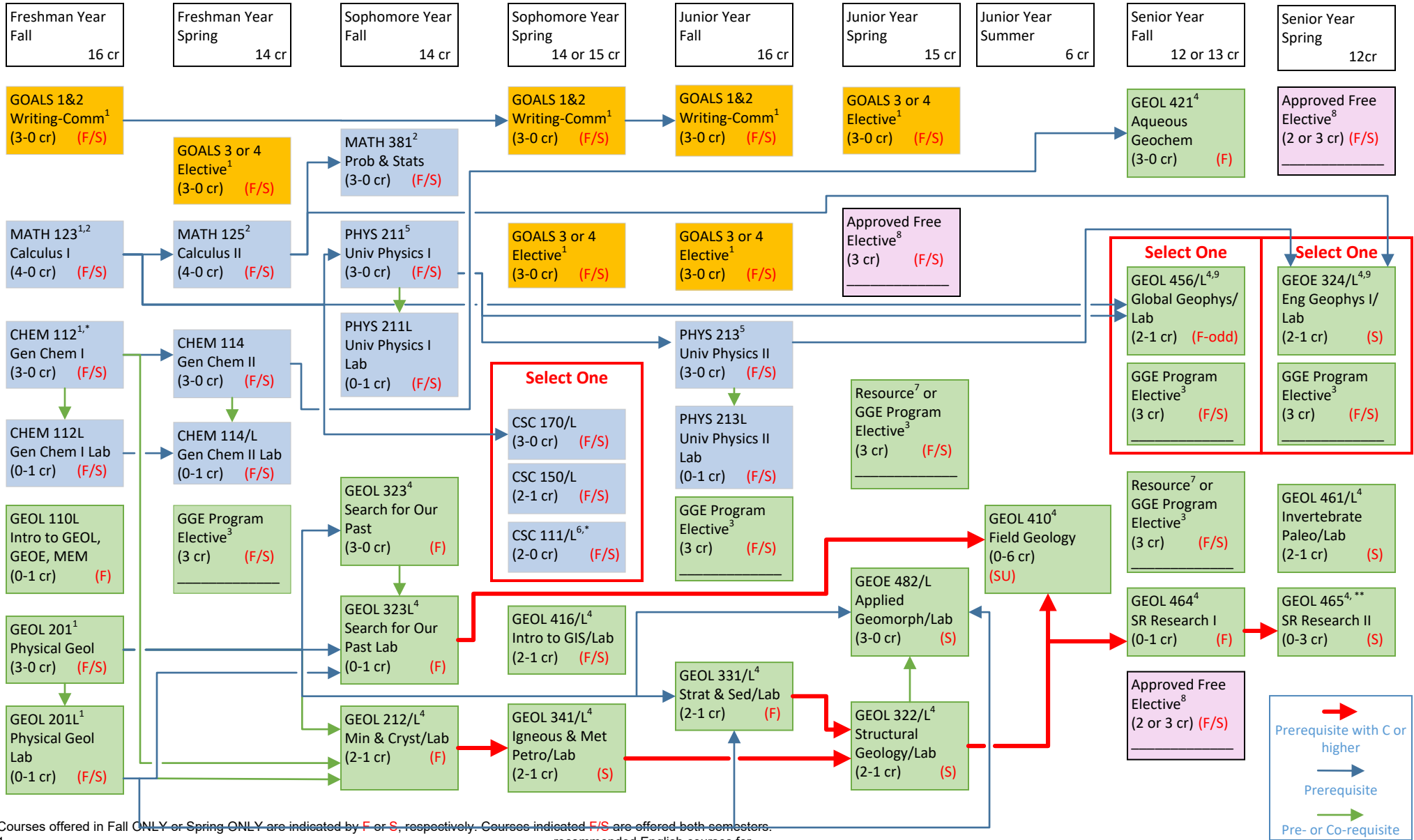


# BS Geology Curriculum Flowchart (2021-22) – 120 credits (Revised August 2021)



Courses offered in Fall ONLY or Spring ONLY are indicated by F or S, respectively. Courses indicated F/S are offered both semesters.

<sup>1</sup>Students complete 30 credits of general education, ENGL 101, ENGL 279, and ENGL 289 are recommended English courses for Geology. Approved general education courses are listed in the catalog.

<sup>2</sup>If preparatory math taken in first semester, the required sequence of MATH 123, MATH 125, and MATH 381 will be offset.

<sup>3</sup>GGE program electives have GEOL or GEOE prefix. At least 6 of 12 total credits must be from 400-level courses.

<sup>4</sup>Grade of C or higher required for graduation with Geology BS and as prerequisite for some courses.

<sup>5</sup>Three credits of PHYS 211 and PHYS 213 required.

<sup>6</sup>One (1) additional elective credit required if CSC 111/111L is taken.

<sup>7</sup>At least one geological resources course required: GEOE 475/475L/575/575L, GEOL 351, GEOL 451/451L, and GEOL 476/576.

<sup>8</sup>Require approval by academic advisor.

<sup>9</sup>One of these two courses required. If both are taken, the second becomes a GGE program elective. \*Minimum MATH 114 prerequisite.
